

Mission offering

This morning we hold a special Church of the Brethren "Mission Offering" which supports ongoing international partnerships with brothers and sisters in Nigeria, Haiti, South Sudan and many other places around the world. The Mission offering helps empower people of all ages to serve through ministries like Brethren Volunteer Service, Global Food Initiative, Children's Disaster Services. Due to COVID-19, giving to denominational ministries has fallen behind this year.

There are several ways you may contribute this year:

- by making your checks payable to Spring Creek COB and write Mission offering on the memo line, or on your offering envelope indicate the amount you wish to go toward the Mission offering.
for donating online with PayPal, please indicate your envelope number as well as the amount you want to contribute (e.g. Envelope #401 \$50 for Mission offering).
for donating online with Stripe, please choose either the General or Mission Offering pull-down, or make multiple designations in one donation by clicking the +add donation button to add a second line item with another designation.
for Text-to-Give, add the word "Mission" to your text (e.g. "\$5 Mission") or split donations between funds in a single text by listing the amounts and fund names for each fund (e.g.: \$5 Mission, \$6 General).

As always, it is hoped this will be a sacrificial gift above and beyond your normal tithe to the church. Thank you for supporting these life changing ministries of the Church of the Brethren.
