## OUTDOOR WORSHIP



As the weather permits this fall, Spring Creek will hold some outdoor Sunday morning services at 11:00 AM on the church lawn for in-person worship. These services will be streamed online, as we have been doing. Watch the weekly announcements for outdoor worship dates, which currently include Sept. 27 and Oct. 4 & 11.

As we gather to worship outside, these are some of the ways we will be looking out for the good and health of one another:

- Bring your own chair and please observe physical distancing guidelines.
- Please wear a face covering until you are seated.
- Restrooms are available by entering the old front doors of the building. Masks should be worn inside the building.
- We will not be passing offering plates.

You can continue to give your offering through online or digital means or mail your offering to the church. We will also have the church mailbox available on Sunday morning to deposit offering envelopes before or after worship. We will not be collecting the offering during the service.

We are reserving the front row of parking for those who would like to remain in their vehicle for worship. Additionally we now have six handicap spaces available next to the sidewalk for those who may wish to attend but do not want to walk on the grass, or wish to remain in their vehicle.

In case of inclement weather we will be streaming the service online as we have been doing with our worship leader participants.
